

Bisc 210: Principles of Microbiology

An introductory course in microbiology emphasizing sanitation, disease, food, and industrial microbiology. The course is designed for students in healthrelated studies such as pre-nursing, nutrition, and pre-dental hygiene. Applies to the laboratory science requirement of the core curriculum.
