

B.S. in Health Information Mgmt (2 +2) Description

The B.S. in health information management (a 2 + 2 program with The University of Mississippi Medical Center) prepares a graduate to work in a variety of medical/clinical settings in the area of collecting, storing, retrieving, and interpreting health-care information.

Course Requirements

The B.S. in health information management degree is a two-phase program. The first phase consists of 61 semester hours on the Oxford campus with a 2.0 minimum GPA. The second phase is in a professional program such as the health information management program offered at The University of Mississippi Medical Center.
