Minor - Intelligence & Security Studies Description

A minor in intelligence and security studies (ISS) familiarizes students with the skills and background necessary for employment as entry-level analysts in the U.S. Intelligence Community.

Course Requirements

A minor in ISS requires student to complete the following courses: ISS 125, ISS 350, ISS 375, ISS 480, ISS 490, and ISS 499. No substitutions are permitted.

Other Academic Requirements

A) ISS 125 is open to all students.

- B) Students who have completed or are taking ISS 125 may apply for the minor. The application process will consider a student's GPA, motivation, choice of major, writing skills and maturity. Not all who apply will likely be accepted.
- C) Students must complete each course in the ISS minor with a grade of "B" or better and must maintain an overall GPA of 3.0. Students not meeting these requirements may be dropped from the minor.
