Accountancy electives	12	Complete at least 12 additional hours of accounting electives chosen from the following courses: Accy 501, 515, 521, 525, 530, 603, 609, 612, 625, 626, 633, and 634. Each course must be completed with a grade of C or better.
Non-accy electives	3	Complete 3 credit hours of nonaccounting electives chosen from any approved 500-level or above course.
GPA requirements		A cumulative average of not less than 3.0 (B) must be achieved in all graduate work taken.
