M.A. in Psychology Description

The Department of Psychology does not offer a terminal master's degree. All graduate students must be accepted into the Ph.D. program and may receive the M.A. as one step in the doctoral program.

Minimum Total Credit Hours: 31 Course Requirements

Completion of the M.A. degree is determined by a recommendation from the student's advisory committee.
