

Minor - Journalism

A minor in journalism requires 18 hours of journalism and integrated marketing communication courses, including at least 9 hours at the 300 level or above. This minor is not valid for those pursuing a major in journalism or integrated marketing communication.

Course Requirements

A MINOR IN JOURNALISM consists of 18 credit hours in the following required courses: Jour 101, either Jour 102 or IMC 204, and four additional journalism courses, three of which must be at the 300 level or above. Grades lower than C in journalism courses will not be counted toward the journalism minor.
