Ph.D. in Health & Kinesiology Description

The Ph.D. prepares students for university teaching and research positions. Also, the degree prepares students for research careers in industry and medicine that include the study of exercise.

Minimum Total Credit Hours: 57

Course Requirements

The course requirements are listed under each emphasis.

Other Academic Requirements

The student also must complete written and oral comprehensive exams before undertaking the prospectus and dissertation.

Emphasis - Exercise Science

The emphasis in exercise science prepares students for university teaching and research positions. Also, the degree prepares students for research careers in industry and medicine that include the study of exercise.

Course Requirements

The course requirements are 18 hours in an exercise science specialty area (selected from either exercise physiology or neuromechanics); 9 hours of research methods and statistics; 12 hours of supporting course work; and 18 hours of dissertation. The specific courses used to satisfy the above requirements must be approved by a student's adviser.

Other Academic Requirements

Additional coursework will be required for students who do not enter the program having completed a master's-level degree in exercise science or closely related discipline.
