

Math 261: Unified Calculus & Analytic Geometry I Mathematics

This course covers differential and integral calculus; analytic geometry introduced, covered in integrated plan where appropriate. Four-term sequence for engineering and science majors.

After completing Math 261 with a C or higher, students may not receive credit for Math 121, Math 125, or Math 267. 3 Credits

• Minimum ACT Mathematics score of 24 (SAT (Pre-2016) 560 or SATR 580); or B minimum in Math 121 and 123; or B minimum in Math 125.
