

B.S. in Health Info & Info Mgmt (2+2) Description

The B.S. in health informatics and information management (a 2+2 program with the University of Mississippi Medical Center) prepares a graduate to work in a variety of medical/clinical settings in the area of collecting, storing, retrieving, and interpreting health care information.

Minimum Total Credit Hours: 117 Course Requirements

The B.S. in health informatics and information management degree is a two-phase program. The first phase consists of 60 semester hours with a 2.5 minimum GPA. The second phase is in a professional program such as the health informatics and information management program offered at the University of Mississippi Medical Center in Jackson, but this program is primarily online. Students must meet minimum criteria and apply by May 15 of the year they desire entry, and admission is competitive. For more information about UMMC admissions, <u>visit the UMMC catalog</u>.
