

DS 099: Intermediate Algebra Developmental Studies

A remedial course for students not yet prepared to take college mathematics. Students with ACT mathematics subscores less than 19, SAT mathematics scores of less than 450 or SATR mathematics scores of less than 510 are required to enroll in DS 099 during their first semester of enrollment and continue in the course until receiving a passing grade. Students with an ACT mathematics subscore of 19 are strongly encouraged to enroll in Intermediate Algebra. Students enrolled in Intermediate Algebra are not allowed to enroll in other mathematics courses (nondegree).
