

Minor - Law Studies Course Requirements

A minor in law studies consists of 18 credit hours in law studies courses including the following required courses: LA 201, LA 204, LA 205, LA 303, and two additional LA courses at the 300 level or above. A minimum grade of C- is required in all courses for the minor. Criminal justice majors can minor in law studies.
