M.S. in Pharmaceutical Sciences

The M.S. in pharmaceutical sciences can be completed with an emphasis in environmental toxicology, medicinal chemistry, pharmaceutics, pharmacology, pharmacognosy, or pharmacy administration.

Minimum Total Credit Hours: 30

Course Requirements

Requirements for each emphasis area are given in the respective program description sections. Each emphasis area requires students to complete a minimum of 24 semester hours of course work and 6 hours of thesis.

Emphasis - Industrial Pharmacy Description

The Department of Pharmaceutics and Drug Delivery at the University of Mississippi is establishing a professional master's in pharmaceutical sciences with an emphasis in industrial pharmacy program (the Professional Master's Program). The Professional Master's Program will be a nonthesis track program designed to provide fundamental and applied knowledge of the pharmaceutical sciences to prepare B.S.-level chemical engineers and scientists (pharmacy, biology and chemistry) for a career in the pharmaceutical industry.

Other Academic Requirements

The Professional Master's Program will not require the completion of a thesis or an examination process. Students will complete several small projects that complement ongoing research in the department instead of a thesis project.
