All incoming undergraduate students wishing to major in public policy leadership (PPL) must apply to the [Lott Leadership Institute](#) for admission. To be considered for admission to the Institute and the PPL program, students must first apply for admission to [The University of Mississippi](#). After admission to the University, the applicant will be able to access the [Special Programs and Scholarship Application](#) by logging in at the same site where they applied initially and returning to the completed application. This application allows students to apply for a variety of special programs offered at the University of Mississippi, including the Sally McDonnell Barksdale Honors College, the Chinese Language Flagship Program, the Arabic Language Flagship Program, and the Croft Institute for International Studies. This application is divided into two parts: the first, which provides general information made available to the student's selected special programs, and the second, which provides sections for each selected program.
