

SAS 606: Academic Reform and APP School of Applied Sciences

This course will examine in detail the NCAA's Academic Performance Program, consisting of Federal Graduation Rate (FGR), Graduation Success Rate (GSR), and Academic Progress Rate (APR). Students will learn the differences between the three rates, calculations, and strategies utilized to maximize rates while ensuring that institutions meet NCAA established benchmarks. The course will also provide an introduction to academic reform and current critiques of the NCAA's academic initiatives.
