

# Fin 303: Money and Banking

Nature and functions of money and banking; relation of money and credit to the American political system, the Federal Reserve system, and national economic goals.

Students may take either Fin 303/Econ 303 OR Fin 333 (Financial Markets and Institutions), but not both for credit toward a degree. 3 Credits
