

Phcy 503: Integrated Systems: Respiratory School of Pharmacy

This module is designed to provide patient-centered care of the respiratory system. It introduces basic concepts of pharmacology and medicinal chemistry particularly as applied to the respiratory system. This course focuses on providing patient-centered care to patients who have a respiratory-based disease state or issue. Learners will develop, integrate, and apply knowledge from the foundational disciplines (i.e., pharmaceutical and clinical sciences) and apply the Pharmacists' Patient Care Process in solving case-based scenarios of patients with respiratory issues.
