

CSD 643: Birth to Five Communication Sciences & Disorders

This course is an advanced study of language impairments in children from birth to five years of age. Students will learn how to classify definitions and theories of language disorders in young children, relate theories of language acquisition to intervention techniques, use norm- referenced tests, criterion-referenced procedures, and behavioral observations for language assessment and treatment planning in the birth to five population. 3 Credits
