

M.S. in Hospitality Mgmt & Leadership

Description

The University of Mississippi's online Master of Science in Hospitality Management and Leadership is a 30-credit-hour program that prepares students for leadership and managerial positions in the hospitality and tourism industry, equipping them with the critical skills and knowledge required for success.

Course Requirements

The M.S. in Hospitality Management and Leadership is a 30-credit-hour program, consisting of 21 credit hours of core courses and 9 credit hours of electives from the list below.

Typical research project AND/OR students would work with a chosen faculty mentor to complete 1-6 hours of NHM 693 with the hour requirements of 100 hours per 1 academic credit hour for an internship experience. NHM 593 would be another option if they needed another independent study.
