

AT 606: Clinical Evaluation in AT II: UE School of Applied Sciences

This course addresses clinical evaluation and assessment techniques of musculoskeletal injuries of the upper extremity. Through didactic and hands-on learning, the student will integrate knowledge of anatomical structures, physiological principles, and evaluative techniques to provide a basis for critical decision making in an injury management environment. Decision making will be based on recognition, evaluation, and immediate care of orthopedic injuries.
