

S St 540: Photographing Place in the U.S. South Center for the Study of Southern Culture

Using the medium of still photography, this course will focus on the relationship between local cultures and the physical world(s) such cultures create. Students will examine the idea of "place," review the visual landscape tradition, consider various examples of "cultural landscape" photography, and discuss student-made photographs, culminating in an exhibit.
