First Year Writing I	3	Complete Hon 101, Writ 100 or Writ 101 with a passing grade.
First Year Writing II	3	Complete one of the following courses with a passing grade: <u>Liba 102</u> , <u>Writ 102</u> or <u>Hon 102</u> .
3 hrs literature 200+	3	Complete 3 hours of literature at the 200 level or higher with a passing grade.
3 hrs Arts Appreciation	3	Complete 3 hours in the area of fine or performing arts. Choose from art history, music, dance, and theatre arts. Studio and workshop courses cannot be used to satisfy this requirement. Acceptable freshman or sophommore-level courses are: AH 101, AH 201, AH 201, AH 202; Music 101, Music 102, Music 103, Music 104, Music 105; Dance 200; and Theatre 201.
Soc 101	3	Complete Soc 101 with a passing grade.
Psy 201	3	Complete Psy 201 with a passing grade.


REQUIREMENT	HOURS	DESCRIPTION
2 Biology courses	6	Complete at least two biology courses chosen from the following: <u>Bisc 102</u> , <u>Bisc 160</u> , <u>Bisc 104</u> , <u>Bisc 162</u> , <u>Bisc 206</u> or <u>Bisc 207</u> . Student will not receive credit for taking BOTH <u>Bisc 102</u> /103 and <u>Bisc 160</u> /161 or <u>Bisc 104</u> /105 and <u>Bisc 162</u> /163.
2 Biology labs	2	Complete at least two biology courses chosen from the following: <u>Bisc 103</u> , <u>Bisc 161</u> , <u>Bisc 105</u> , <u>Bisc 163</u> , <u>Bisc 206</u> or <u>Bisc 207</u> . Student will not receive credit for taking BOTH <u>Bisc 102</u> /103 and <u>Bisc 160</u> /161 or <u>Bisc 104</u> /105 and <u>Bisc 162</u> /163.
3 hrs Chem or Phys	3	Successfully complete 3 credit hours of physical science chosen from the following subject areas: chemistry or physics.
3 hrs Math 121 or higher	3	Successfully complete Math 121 or a higher level math with a passing grade.
3 hrs statistics course	3	Sucessfully complete a statistic course from the following list of courses: Math 115, Econ 230, Bus 230 or Psy 202.
Writ 250	3	Complete Writ 250 with a passing grade.
3 hrs humanities of fine arts	3	Complete 3 hrs chosen from: African American Studies (<u>AAS 201 OR 202</u>); Classics (Clc); <u>Envs 101</u> ; Gender Studies (<u>G St 201, 202</u> , or <u>301</u>); Southern Studies (<u>S St 100</u> level); History (Hst), Literature (<u>Eng 220</u> -226); Philosophy (Phil), Religion (Rel), honors freshman seminar (if not used for composition)
